Sisters of the Little Habit



The Sisters of the Visitation are a contemplative community of nuns founded in the 17th century by St. Jane de Chantal and St. Francis de Sales. The sisters live in Tyringham, MA and seek to live in union with the Sacred and Immaculate Hearts in a monastery entitled Mont Deux Coeurs (Mount of two hearts).

The *Sisters of the Little Habit* are handmade by the sisters to support their life of prayer. The name signifies that each sister is created with an authentic replication of the habit of the order and has a tie to their history when very young sisters were called sisters of the little habit.

Each figure is a representation of some aspect of the sisters' lives and/or history.
